MANAGEMENT OF WASTE

The company will ensure that waste is disposed of by a registered waste disposal company, transfer notes obtained and has particular regard to the safe disposal of hazardous waste. Where hazardous waste such as asbestos is concerned it is company policy and a legal requirement that it is handled by and disposed of by a specialist registered sub-contractor.

ENERGY AND WATER EFFICIENCY

Where possible, the company will ensure both water and energy efficiency. This is not only good environmental practice but will offer financial benefits to the company.

POLLUTION

Especially where the disposal of chemical waste is concerned, pollution is a particular hazard. There are already laws which deal with the disposal of waste and the effect of pollution on the environment, e.g. paint cannot be disposed of in drains, rivers etc., to which this company adheres. We hold data sheets and make C.O.S.H.H. Assessments on all of the products that we use and ensure that waste is dealt with in a way which does not cause pollution.

MATERIAL PURCHASING

Predominantly, materials to be used are dictated by the client. There are various environmentally friendly building products available on the market and these can be made available if so required.

This policy is subject to regular review so that changes brought about by internal or external influences are incorporated. Compliance with the environmental management policy is mandatory to all employees of B Price Limited. It is our aim where appropriate, we will try to ensure that all materials are recycled.
